Assessment methods	Trinity's drama diplomas are taken individually. ATCL performing exams are taken with one examiner present in the room who watches the work presented. The examiner writes a report and awards marks in line with the assessment criteria, learning outcomes and attainment descriptors published in the syllabus. ATCL and LTCL Teaching and Performing diplomas also include a written examination and a submitted materials submission.						

Attainment	ATCL and LTCL are marked out of 100. The pass mark is 50. Distinction is					
levels	awarded for 75 and over. FTCL is Approved or Not Approved.

Minimum age and other entry requirements	Trinity's drama diplomas are open to all candidates. There is no requirement to have passed lower grade levels, or other qualifications;					
	however, the grades and diplomas represent a system of progressive					
	development and the outcomes for each level assume mastery of the					
	outcomes of previous grades therefore we recommend that candidates					
	have taken the previous level particularly at these higher levels. There					
	is no upper age limit, but the following recommended guidance is					
	provided regarding the minimum age for each stage:
